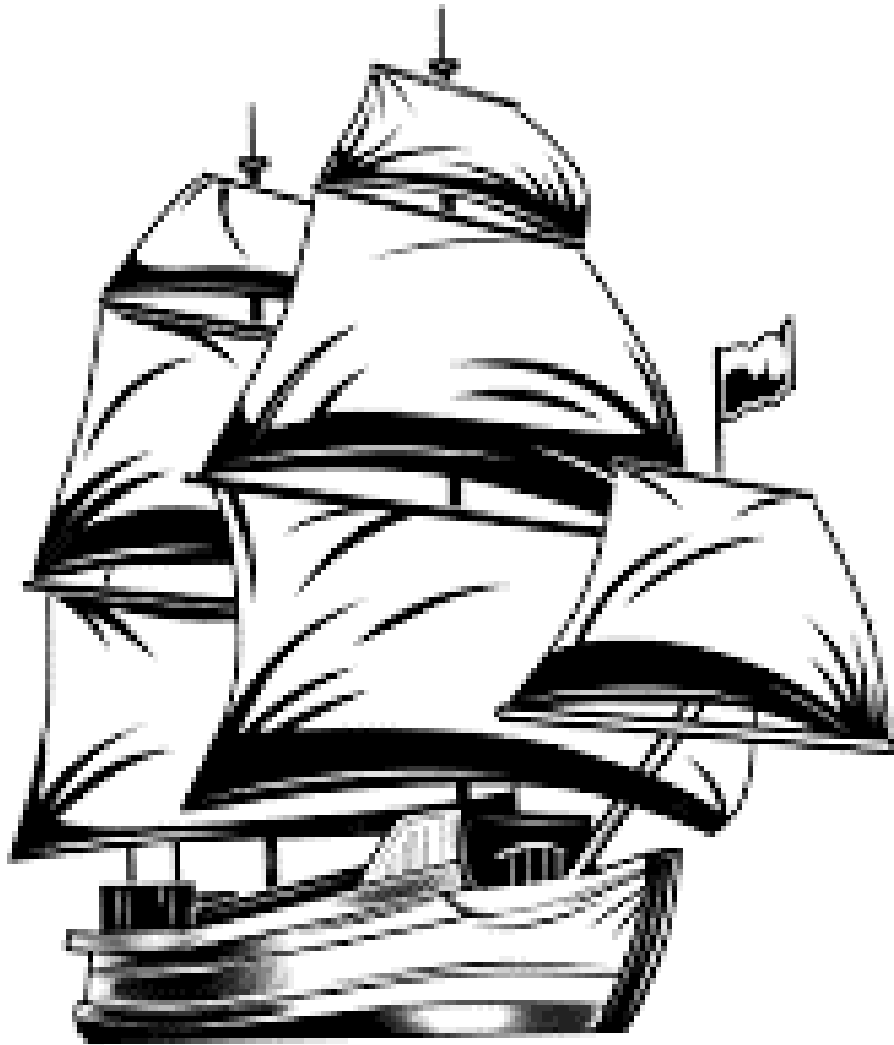

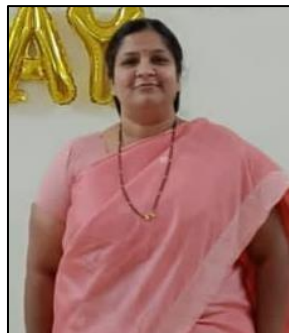

Session I: Welcome note & Familiarization with the Department

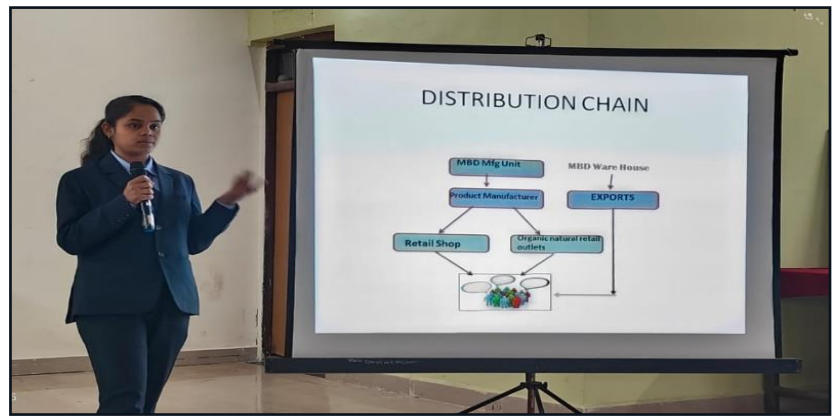

Day 3 Sindhudurg Fort:

We visited Sindhudurg Fort – One of the best-preserved forts occupying an islet in the Arabian Sea on the shore of Malvan town of Sindhudurg district in the Konkan region. The fort is spread over 48 acres, with a 3 km long rampart with 42 bastions, and walls that are 30 feet high and 12 feet thick. The main entrance is concealed in such a way that no one can locate it from outside. The Fort houses three sweet water reservoirs, a handprint and a footprint of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, a temple dedicated to Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj.



Devbagh Beach

Devbagh beach is a Very Beautiful holiday destination. A famous beach for Water Sports, Sea Eagles, Tsunami Island, Beach stay, Dolphin sightings. This temple is one of the largest and most frequently visited temples in Goa. In 2011, the temple along with others in the area instituted a dress code on visitors of the temple.



The Basilica of Bom Jesus

After Manguesh sansthan we visited The Basilica of Bom Jesus (Portuguese: *Basílica do Bom Jesus*; Konkani: *Borea Jezuchi Bajilika*) is a Catholic basilica located in Goa, in the Konkani region of India. The iconic church is a pilgrimage center and recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. The basilica is located in Old Goa, the former capital of Portuguese India, and holds the mortal remains of St Francis Xavier. One of Goa's oldest churches, its construction was started in 1594 and was consecrated in 1605 by Archbishop Dom Father Aleixo de Menezes. There is an exposition every ten years to venerate the body of this Saint. The next exposition will be held in the year 2024.



Dona Paula Jetty

On 16th January at evening our group of students visited one of Goa's finest tourist destinations, surrounded by many luxury hotels and institutes in the suburbs of Panaji. This location, also known as lover's paradise, is popular for its superlative beaches, unique locales, and mysterious legends, and has served as an iconic spot in many Bollywood movies.

Day 5

Fort Aguada

On 17th January 2024 we visited Fort Aguada, it is a well-preserved seventeenth-century Portuguese fort, along with a lighthouse, standing in Goa, India, on Sinquerim Beach, overlooking the Arabian Sea. It is an ASI protected Monument of National Importance in Goa. The fort was originally constructed in 1612 to guard against the Dutch. It was a reference point for the vessels coming from Europe at that time. This old Portuguese fort stands on the beach south of Candolim, at the shore of the Mandovi River. It was initially tasked with defense of shipping and the nearby Bardez sub-district.



After experiencing beauty Fort Agauda we had fun at Baga a seaside town in Bardez, Goa, India. It comes under the jurisdiction of Calangute, which is 2 km south. Baga is known for its popular beach and Baga Creek. It is visited by thousands of tourists annually. Discovered by the Hippies, Baga became an important stopover on the Hippie trail during the sixties and seventies. Years after Hippies popularized it; Baga continues to retain the ethos and characteristics of the movement minus the decadence associated with it. Baga is located in North Goa, 16 km from the state capital Panaji. Calangute Beach is to its south and Anjuna Beach to its north. The Baga river skirts the sides of the beach, ultimately to flow into the Arabian Sea. Baga Beach starts right where Calangute ends. However, it's hard to pinpoint exactly where.

The best way to explore Parra and the surrounding areas in Goa is on two wheels. Visitors can conveniently rent scooters or motorcycles and utilize the Goa App, which offers easy navigation to various destinations, including the Coconut Tree Road.

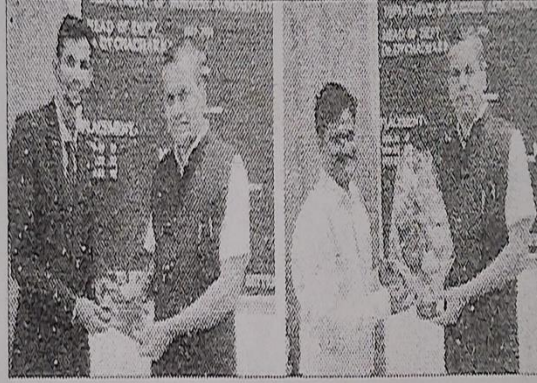
